







N/TT Scale Station

Thanks for purchasing one of my kits.

This kit just requires **Gel glue**. Please keep all parts away from children



A non super glue Gel glue is recommended



Firstly cut out and glue the windows and doors as shown left, place the windows in place first just to make sure they are the right way around.



Now glue the 2 panels with the round window to the front long section as shown left, make sure the edges are flush.



Find the 2x gable ends and the 2x pieces of plain card they are the same length as the gables, glue them to the flat surface making sure they are flush with the bottom and sides.







Glue the remaining pieces of card as shown, just make sure they are flush with the bottom.





Find the 3 pieces shown left, glue the plain piece to the back of the slate piece, make sure it's flush with one bottom and both sides as shown right, now glue the little facia in the ridge as shown below.











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Find the 2x brick sections with the round hole and gently fold the edges as shown left.

Now glue all the brick sections in place as shown right.










Now we can glue the walls together, run a line of glue down the edges getting some in the slots, it will be a bit flimsy at this stage don't worry, go and make a cup of tea just to give it a few minutes to bond.



Run a line of glue on top the supports we fixed earlier, then gently push the middle floor in place, make sure it passes the windows ok, then glue the 2x roof supports as shown right.











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Run a line of glue on all the edges of the main building to get ready to fix the main roof, let the glue gel for a few mins then put the main roof in place, just spend a few mins making sure it's stuck all round, then run a line of glue on top of the 2 plastic gables to fix the smaller roofs, again give the glue time to go tacky, it sticks faster.

Ok good job!! now we can glue the door canopy in place, only glue the back edge we don't want to get any glue on the walls as we push it back, I put mine straight but you can fix it on a slight slope if required.



Just the chimneys then good to go, I hope you've enjoyed building it..
